


*Friends of San Leandro Creek*

Celebrate the first day of spring with a hike in the Upper San Leandro Creek watershed. We'll be hiking in Redwood Regional Park along the Redwood Creek tributary. This round-trip six mile hike takes us through the "elfin forest" of Huckleberry Botanical Preserve and coast redwood forest. Our turn around point is where the rainbow trout was first discovered in 1855.

Participants should be able to walk for at least five hours with short breaks. Water and restrooms are available at the trailhead and during the hike. Please bring water and snack for the trail. Most of the hike is in the shade.



Please meet at the Skyline Gate Staging Area located on Skyline Blvd. .4 mile south of the junction with Shepard Canyon Road and Pinehurst Road.
