



Watershed Hike Series

Lake Chabot

Enjoy a beautiful autumn morning at Lake Chabot. We'll visit Chabot Dam and other historic reminders of early settlements of San Leandro. We'll learn about the dam's history and impact on San Leandro Creek's lower watershed. Then we'll head north and enjoy the chaparral terrain of the lands surrounding Lake Chabot.

The hike will be on paved and unpaved trails. There is some elevation gain. Participants should be able to walk for at least three hours with short breaks. There are two restroom stops available on this trail, but please bring water. Most of the hike is exposed except for small areas of shade, so a hat is recommended. Please wear appropriate hiking clothes and footwear.

Please meet at Chabot Park at the end of Estudillo in San Leandro.
